Save money and energy with the Cycled Air Conditioning program!

Special \$25 “cycle now” incentive credit

ECE's Cycled Air program is your opportunity to take advantage of a one-time \$25 incentive credit when you sign up, plus \$10 credits (each month) for June, July and August, while still keeping your home cool and comfortable. By signing up for the Cycled Air program, your air conditioner is cycled on and off approximately every 15 minutes only during peak demand periods. Your circulation fan continues to circulate air in your home or cabin during “control” periods.

It's simple to convert either standard or high-efficiency central air conditioning units to the Cycled Air program. All you need is a radio control available from East Central Energy. The radio receiver serves as a switch that controls the central air conditioners on the program and is mounted on your home or power pole.

Air conditioning rebate program

High efficiency and quality installation rebate qualifications

The 2012 air conditioning rebate program focuses on quality installation as well as high-efficient equipment. Basic rebate qualifications are as follows:

- System must be a central ducted system with outdoor condenser unit and indoor evaporator coil designed by manufacturer to work together to perform maximum efficiency
- System must be installed within ECE service territory, and between January 1 and December 31, 2012.
- A registered contractor must perform the installation and complete all required system sizing, testing and documentation. Rebate forms are available through your registered contractor.
- Call ECE or visit eastcentralenergy.com for the registered contractor list.

Rebate amounts depend on seasonal energy efficiency ratio (SEER) of equipment installed. Verification of rating is available at www.ahridirectory.org.

Rebate amounts based on SEER rating		
SEER Rating	Central Air Conditioner	Central Air Source Heat Pump
13.0 – 14.4	\$30	\$330
14.5 – 14.9	\$180	\$480
15.0 – 15.9	\$280	\$580
16 +	\$330	\$630

- Rebates are awarded on a first-come, first-served basis and will be issued in the form of a bill credit.
- Limit one rebate per member account.
- Cycling of A/C or ASHP system is encouraged, but not required to receive rebate. Cycling of ASHP is required to receive reduced kWh rate.
